

# MarvelClient and Your End Users

MarvelClient is 100% transparent to your end users – including the initial installation (when using the Mailbox PostOpen Script option or corporate software deployment).

The whole management – and in many cases also the initial installation – is done from the Configuration database, **your central control unit**.

In general, MarvelClient is entirely invisible for end users, except for the following cases:

- You choose for a Mailbased Install where the user needs to open the MarvelClient Install Mail (as opposed to using a Mailbox Postopen Script, where the user only needs to open his or her mailbox – also see [Client Setup](#))
- You define Actions that access the server before the end-user has effectively logged into the Notes client (this would display a small password dialog during client startup prior to the usual login dialog)
- You have created an Action that needs input from the end-user
- You enforce full replication of select databases during client startup (this leads to the display of a progress bar)
- You create a backup Action using replication (this leads to the display of a progress bar for each replicated database)
- You use a roaming/rollback Action using replication (this leads to the display of a progress bar for each replicated database)
- You display optional progress information during potentially lengthy Actions
- You enable the display of MarvelClient progress information during client shutdown
- You have licensed MarvelClient Zip/Unzip or Attachment Blocking
