All panagenda knowledge base contents can be exported as visually appealing PDF files.

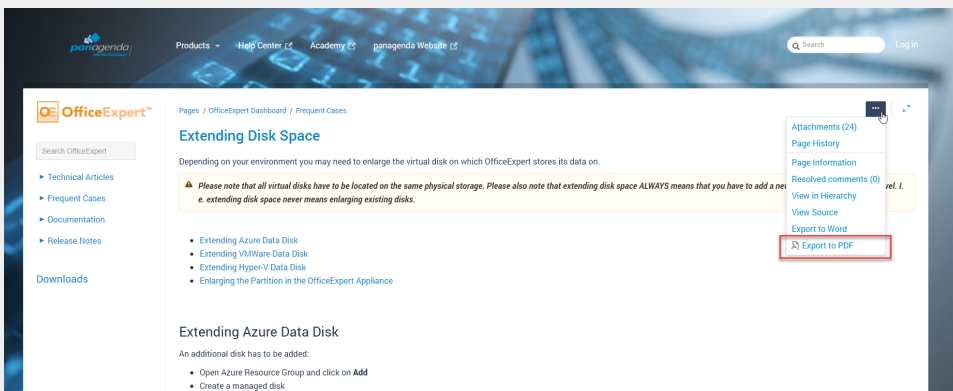
To export articles, please carry out the following steps:

1. Navigate to the page you want to page you want to export.

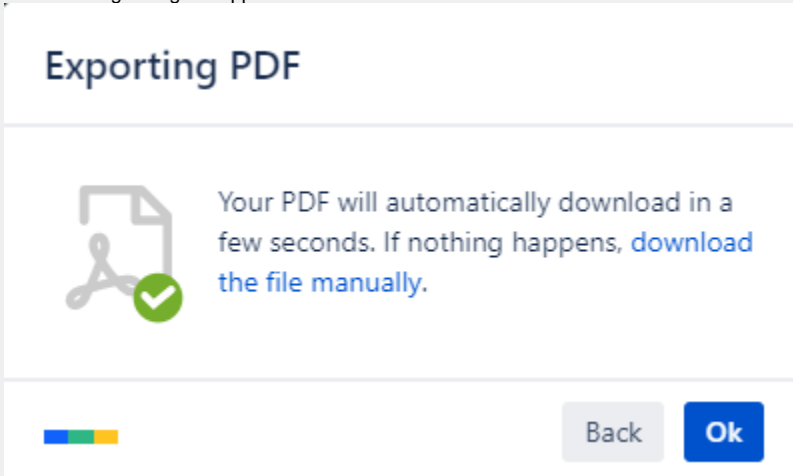
