

Extend DomLog Data Collection

In order to save resources, the collection of DomLog data in iDNA Applications is limited to its essentials. Cookie and referrer data, as well as status codes 302 and 304 are not collected per default.

If you need to extend data collection to its full scope, please follow these steps:

1. Use the **ssh client** of your choice (e.g. [putty](#) on Windows) to connect to the appliance and **edit** the following **properties file** (e.g. using [vim](#)):

```
vim /opt/panagenda/appdata/volumes/idna/idna-config.properties
```

2. **Add** the following **settings** at the end of the properties file:

Properties for access log:

```
domino.server.domlog.import.accesslog.exclude_cookie_data=false
domino.server.domlog.import.accesslog.exclude_referer_data=false
domino.server.domlog.import.accesslog.exclude_status_codes=
```

Properties for domlog:

```
domino.server.domlog.import.ndb.exclude_cookie_data=false
domino.server.domlog.import.ndb.exclude_referer_data=false
domino.server.domlog.import.ndb.exclude_status_codes=
```

3. **Save** the properties file and **exit**
4. **Reboot** the iDNA Application appliance with the following command:

```
ifa restart
```
