### [My HCLSoftware Portal](#)

Launched in 2023, this is a great site to use for downloading newer versions of HCL collaboration software like Notes/Domino. Downloads are fast and it's easy to find things. Log in with the same credentials you use for FlexNet, and you'll find categories and links for the software you're entitled to. It doesn't have everything, and some older versions might be missing, but it's a good place to start.

This is the landing page for HCL support, including the [Knowledgebase](#). If you're a registered customer, there's also a link to create a case (trouble ticket) with support.

### [How to Use Flexnet](#)

Flexnet is the system HCL uses to manage software licenses and downloads. However, it's not always easy to use. We recommend using the [My HCLSoftware Portal](#) when you can, but if you need to use FlexNet this article has some good tips.
