



Sensor Configuration

- Where do I find the Sametime Simulation sensors?**
 - ▶ **Menu 'Monitoring Configuration' > 'Sensor Settings'**
 - a) Select the 'Menu' icon at the bottom of the window
 - b) Select the 'Monitoring Configuration' icon on the left hand side
 - c) Select the 'Sensor Settings' button below the list box
 - d) The sensors 'Sametime Chat Simulation', 'Sametime Meeting Simulation' and 'Sametime Multisite' are shown in the right part of the list box

- What should always be considered when configuring Sametime Simulation sensors?**
 - ▶ **Use dedicated Sametime user accounts for each sensor**
Never share or re-use them with other sensors

- Where do I find the result of a complete simulation cycle for a web meeting?**
 - ▶ **Check sensor results page of the particular sensor**
 - a) Double click 'Server' on the 'Health Grid'
 - b) Click on 'Open Sensor Details'
 - c) Click on the specific sensor name of the Sametime meeting simulation

- Identify slow login times to a Sametime Community and/or WebMeeting Server**
 - ▶ **Check sensor results page of the specific sensor**
 - a) Double click 'Server' on the 'Health Grid'
 - b) Click on 'Open Sensor Details'
 - c) Select the 'Community Server' sensor by following the tree path: greenlight.sametime.community.server.login.time
 - d) Select the 'Meeting Server' sensor by following the tree path: greenlight.sametime.meeting.server.login.time

- Determine whether the upload of an attachment to the WebMeeting infrastructure was quick or slow**
 - ▶ **Check sensor results page of the specific sensor**
 - a) Double click 'Server' on the 'Health Grid'
 - b) Click on 'Open Sensor Details'
 - c) Select the 'Upload' sensor by following the tree path: greenlight.sametime.meeting.doc.upload.1mb.time

- Determine the overall Sametime Community and/or WebMeeting Server availability via Report Definitions**
 - ▶ **Menu 'Monitoring Configuration' > 'Sensor Settings'**
 - a) Select the 'Menu' icon at the bottom of the window
 - b) Select the 'Report' icon on the left hand side
 - c) Select the 'Report Definitions' button below the list box
 - d) The reports 'Meeting Server Availability' and 'Community Server Availability' are shown in the right part of the list box
